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Womb cancer

- > Bleeding in between periods, after menopause or after sex
- > Heavier periods
- > Vaginal discharge – pink/watery/brown/prune colour

Cervical cancer

- > Bleeding between periods, during or after sex or after menopause
- > Pain during sex
- > Changes to vaginal discharge
- > Unexplained pain in lower back or abdomen

Vaginal cancer

- > Bleeding between periods, during or after sex or after menopause
- > Smelly or blood-stained discharge
- > Pain during sex
- > A vaginal lump
- > Persistent vaginal itch
- > Pain when urinating (weeing)/needing to urinate more regularly

Ovarian cancer

- > Persistent bloating
- > Pelvic/abdominal pain
- > Loss of appetite/feeling full quickly, or feeling nauseous
- > Needing to urinate (wee) more or more urgently
- > Change in bowel habits

Vulval cancer

- > Persistent itch
- > Pain or soreness
- > Thickened, raised, red, lighter or darker patches on the skin of the vulva
- > Lump on the vulva
- > An open sore or growth
- > A mole that changes shape or colour
